Laborshed Studies

Fee-for-Service

Labor availability study of people ages 18-64, based on commuting patterns into a community.

- Community Analysis

- Industry Analysis

Regional Skillshed

Fee-for-Service

Identification of the gap between the skills of residents within a region and the skills needed by employers to fill current and projected vacancies.

Dislocated Worker Analysis

Aggregate worker analysis based on a group of individuals that have been/will be separated from employment by employer.

Iowa College Student Report

Survey and analysis of college students (community college and private and public universities) consisting of questions pertaining to students' demographics, areas of study, future ambitions, opinions of the state of Iowa, and what would attract them to relocate/stay in the state of Iowa.

Workforce Needs Assessment

Employer survey identifying the current and upcoming job vacancies including skill identification and wage expectations.

Educational Outcomes

Custom research designed to assist colleges/universities in the determination of the effectiveness of their educational programming through education and wage record matching.

Fringe Benefit Profile

Fee-for-Service

Employer survey of fringe benefit packages (i.e. insurance, paid leave, and retirement/pension plans) offered to employees, both full and part-time. This analysis is compiled by industry or employment size.

Unemployment Insurance Statistical Data

Unemployment insurance statistics includes unemployment insurance benefits paid and number of UI recipients by county. It also includes statewide UI workload reporting data, employer contribution data and UI trust fund solvency analysis.
